Fighters must be over 18 years of age and be minimum 6th Kyu.

Men's Category

Category 1 - Lightweight Category (- 70 Kg)

Category 2 - Middle-weight Category (+ 70-80 Kg.)

Category 3 - Heavy-weight Category (+ 80 Kg.)

Women's Category

Category 1 (- 60 Kg.)

Category 2 (+60 Kg.)

Fighter Protection

Men - Approved Shin and in step protectors and groin guards. Gum shields are optional at the fighters discretion.

Women - Approved Shin and in step protectors and approved breast protectors, hands must be taped
